



FIRST ADVISORY BOARD MEETING















ONLINE MEETINGS

On October 28, 2024, a virtual meeting was held with the participation of partners from Jordan, Palestine, and Portugal.

The main objective of the meeting was to distribute tasks among the partners from Palestine and Jordan to facilitate the preparation of materials that will be developed as part of the project. The Portuguese partner was responsible for distributing tasks, providing guidance, and defining the nature of the content to be developed. This work falls under Work Package 4 (WP4).

The intended objective was successfully achieved, and the materials were prepared on time in both English and Arabic.



On December 19, 2024, a virtual meeting was held to discuss Work Packages 1, 4, 5, and 6.

The objective of the meeting was to review progress, address challenges, and coordinate upcoming tasks related to these work packages.

In addition to discussing the work packages (1, 4, 5, and 6), the meeting also covered several important topics, including financial matters and accreditation issues.
